CADDO CAREER & TECHNOLOGY CENTER COURSES

DIGITAL ART COURSES

- **Media Arts In Advertising:** *Enriched Credit.* Put your artistic talent to good use with designing print advertising. Create projects using Adobe Illustrator & InDesign applications, along with Wacom drawing tablets. Experience the competitive world of advertising, art competitions and client hands-on projects. *IBC: Adobe Certified Associate in Illustrator and InDesign.* (DE) (WBL)
- **Digital Animation:** *Enriched Credit.* This course is for students who like to draw and create animation using traditional and digital techniques. Students prepare for careers in TV, film and video games. *IBC: Adobe Animate and After Effects.* 5th/6th periods only. (DE)
- **Digital Media:** *Enriched Credit.* Learn to create video productions and photography through a fast-paced course focusing on the development of effective, efficient, and appealing visual productions. *IBC: Adobe Certified Associate in Premiere Pro.* (DE)
- **Graphic Arts:** Learn to make eye-catching designs, restore and colorize old photos, and much more using Adobe Photoshop. Second year students will learn to create posters, build a magazine, and more using Adobe InDesign. *IBC: Adobe Certified Associate in Photoshop and InDesign.* (DE) (WBL)

HEALTH CARE COURSES

- **Dental Assistant:** *Enriched Credit.* Become certified to take dental x-rays and make patient study models. Learn dental procedures while exploring a variety of dental careers. Prerequisite: C or Higher in Biology. *IBC: Dental Radiology and NOCTI Test.* (WBL)
- **Emergency Medical Technician:** *Enriched Credit.* Prepares students to provide pre-hospital assessment and care for patients of all ages with a variety of medical conditions and traumatic injuries. Prerequisites: 16 years of age. *IBC: Emergency Medical Responder.*
- **First Responder:** *Enriched Credit.* Teaches students to provide emergency care to victims of accidents or illnesses. Prerequisite: 16 years of age. *IBC: Emergency Medical Responder.* (DE) Fall Semester Only.
- **Medical Terminology:** *Enriched Credit.* Provides knowledge of medical terms used in the health care professions. (DE) Spring Semester Only.
- **Patient Care Technician:** *Enriched Credit.* Students interested in the field of medicine learn direct patient care. Observe and apply your medical skills in our new cutting-edge medical lab. Prerequisites: 16 years of age, C or higher in Biology. Seniors and juniors in good academic standing. *IBC: Patient Care Technician.* (DE)

HUMAN SERVICE COURSES

- **Culinary Arts:** Learn food preparation service, safety and sanitation. Train as cooks, chefs, kitchen workers, commercial food equipment operators, line workers, and waiters/waitresses. *IBC: ServSafe Manager and ProStart.* (WBL)
- **Ducks Unlimited Ecology Conservation & Management:** *Enriched Credit.* This course teaches individuals knowledge and skills in the areas of ecological principles and wildlife conservation and management. 5th/6th periods only. Maximum: 12 students. *IBC: DUECM Certification.*
- **Fashion Design:** Explore the world of fashion and experience the dynamics of creating, producing and marketing your own fashion creations. *IBC: Penn Foster Business of Retail.* (WBL)
- **Fashion Styling, Costume Design, & Makeup Artistry:** This course brings together fashion design and makeup artistry for film, photography, and fashion management. *IBC: Penn Foster Business of Retail.* (WBL)
- **Marketing I, II:** (Offered Periods 1/2 & 3/4 only) Examine activities in marketing and retailing for success in employment and post-secondary education. Explore careers in marketing, finance, hospitality, management and entrepreneurship. *IBC: Customer Service.*
- **Marketing (DECA):** (Offered Periods 5/6/7 only to Caddo Magnet, Captain Shreve, and Southwood students). Learn while you earn! Combine part-time retail employment with classroom instruction. Prerequisite: 2.0 GPA or higher. *IBC: Customer Service.* (WBL)
- **Teaching Professions:** *Enriched Credit.* Gain insight into the nature of teaching. Students are expected to have and maintain at least a 2.5 overall grade point average. (DE, WBL)

SKILLED TRADE COURSES

- **Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC):** Learn the theory and principles of heating, ventilation, and air conditioning. *IBC: EPA 608.* (DE) (WBL)
- **Carpentry/Spanish Carpentry:** Use a combination of power and hand tools to build various projects such as furniture and storage buildings while learning to read blueprints. **Spanish Carpentry can be taken by all students.** *IBC: CITF Career Connection Level 1.* (WBL)
- **Electrical:** Learn how to install electrical systems in structures. Students learn wiring, circuit breaker panels, switches, light fixtures, and blueprint reading. *IBC: Electrical Training Alliance.* (DE) (WBL)
- **Machine Shop:** Train as a machinist by building machine parts using lathes, mills, drills, grinders, and CNC (computer numerical controlled) machines. *IBC: S/P2 and NIMS Level 1.* (DE) (WBL)
- **Welding:** Build skills in oxy-acetylene, arc, MIG welding techniques. Develop skills in scale reading, linear measurement, blueprint reading, and layouts. *IBC: CITF Career Connection Level 1.* (DE) (WBL)
- **Survey of Skilled Trades:** This project-based course explores units in carpentry, electrical, plumbing, welding, air conditioning, and cold-metal working. Students will learn area-specific tool use and safety. This one credit/one semester course is the perfect introduction to CCTC skilled trade courses. *IBC: S/P2 and OSHA 10.* **(Available in Spanish)**

TECHNOLOGY COURSES

- **App Development/Software Programming:** *Enriched Credit.* Students will learn to "code" using the Java programming language. Develop high quality, working software applications that solve real-world problems. *IBC: JAVA, Comp TIA IT Fundamentals.* (WBL)
- **Drafting/CAD:** *Enriched Credit.* Master the latest techniques and innovations in our high-tech computer-aided drafting lab. Gain valuable experience in the areas of machine, architecture, piping, structural, electrical and mapping. *IBC: Autodesk Certified User: AutoCAD.* (WBL)
- **Networking/Information Technologies/Computer Science:** *Enriched Credit.* Students study topics from networking and operating systems to mobile devices and programming. Students learn the skills needed to design, build, and maintain small to medium-sized networks and to manipulate information technology for a variety of business and industry applications. *IBC: CompTIA A+, CompTIA IT Fundamentals.* (DE) (WBL)
- **Web Design and Content Creation:** *Enriched Credit.* This course will introduce students to a variety of methods for creating websites. They will learn to work with graphics, dynamic web content, and uploading their sites to the web. *IBC: CIW Site Development.* (DE)

TRANSPORTATION COURSES

- **Automotive Technician:** Learn to repair the latest makes and models of cars/trucks in the areas of brakes, electrical/electronics, steering/suspension, engine repair/performance, heating/air conditioning, manual drive train/axle, and automatic transmission/transaxle. *IBC: S/P2 and ASE Certifications.* (DE) (WBL)
- **Collision Repair:** Learn to repair damaged frames, body metal, and body plastics through hands-on guidance and experience. Paint cars and operate the frame machine, air files, sanders, and acetylene/electric-arc welders. *IBC: S/P2, ICAR Platinum, ASE Certification.* (WBL)

LEGEND

DE (Dual Enrollment): A program of study allowing high school students to earn credits simultaneously toward a high school diploma and a post-secondary degree or certificate.

IBC (Industry-Based Certification): A portable, recognized credential that validates an individual has successfully demonstrated skill competencies in a core set of content and performance standards in a specific set of work related tasks, single occupational area, or a cluster of related occupational areas.

WBL (Work-Based Learning): Activities at the high school level that involve actual work experience that connect classroom learning to work.

All CCTC classes are offered during 1/2, 3/4, and 5/6 periods unless noted in the descriptions above.
